- Type of Open Source Software.
 - General Used Software such as Operating
 Systems (Window Base & Text Base), Office
 Applications, etc
 - Specific Used Software such as
 - Development Tools ; DBMS, Software Languages, etc
 - Specific Applications : mail Server, web
 Server, LMS, ERP system, etc

- SIPA has set up Suriyan and Chantra Project
 - Suriyan is an operating system that develop base from Ubuntu
 - Chantra is a collection of open source software that can run on Microsoft windows.
- SIPA has website name http://suriyan.in.th and http://chantra.in.th for Thai developers who want to participate our projects.
- SIPA support for teacher to use this type of Open source software in their course at all levels education.

- SIPA has the training material like the manual and VDO training for Open Source Software more than 7 titles for example OpenOffice.org, Gimp, Blender, Chantra, Suriyan, Pspp (statistical analysis software), Ubuntu, Linux Security etc.
- SIPA has published our training material on Internet and produce it in CD format
- SIPA has distributed all training CD to numerous government agencies.

- SIPA held more than 6 seminars per year to give the opportunity for Open source Entrepreneurs to sell solution for their customer such as Government Agency and Private Sector.
- SIPA has produced DVD media to present the success story of organization that migrate to use open source and it is available for all interested people.

- SIPA has established web site name http://mirror.in.th to collected most popular use open source software in Thailand. And it helps users to consider which open source software are solution of their requirement, since it has been established, it has user download more than 100,000 times.

Strategies for using OpenOffice.org in Thailand by SIPA

- SIPA has updated training manuals and video training since OpenOffice.org 2.X - 3.X regularly and published on the Internet and on CD format.
- All training material contain content from beginning to intermediate level of OpenOffice.org user
- SIPA has created a capabilities testing system learning on CD, so if some people want to measure their skill, they can do it easy by themselves. And this training materials are available for interested agency.

Strategies for using OpenOffice.org in Thailand by SIPA

- SIPA encourage some software companies to publish OpenOffice.org handbook. And sold in retail book stores.
- SIPA has get permission from the Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand to published their OpenOffice.org Troubleshooting guide book on the Internet. With this book will allow users to solve OpenOffice.org problems by themselves more easier.
- SIPA has creates Thai language knowledge base system to collect about the problem from OpenOffice.org user, so they can find the answers by themselves via the website http://www.openoffice.in.th

- SIPA has created Thai language VDO to recommended the ways to solve OpenOffice.org problem for 150 issue and all of the VDO will post on Youtube that allow users to search more easily.
- SIPA held the training for GCC 1111 (Government Call Center) staff to help users solving their problems, when using OpenOffice.org.
- We try to promote for Government Organization to use open standard file format.
- SIPA has the policy for our staff who want new notebook. They have to install Ubuntu linux only, so it can make huge of success to change software user behavior for our staff.
